



IPHONE TOP 10 TIPS N TRICKS

Make sure under settings/camera/formats is on the highest capture rate it can be.

Clean your lens on the back of the phone, so many forget this and wonder why their phones are “foggy”

When taking a selfie, you can squeeze the volume up button on the side of your iPhone to snap the picture.

Turn on the grid for better composition of our images and tap the subject to get that sharp focus.

Activate the grid lines by going to the Camera section of your iPhone’s settings and toggling the Grid switch to on.

Try using portrait mode for much more than portraits, great for food and product shots as well.

Consider accessories such as a tripod and a mini led light. As all inbuilt flashes can produce weird results.

Search features since update in iOS 11 allow you to search for images if you haven’t put them in to folders.

Updates since simply type in orange ball 2020 and the phone will find the images.

Pick the right orientation for your subject, not sure take one image with both portrait and landscape orientation.

Have some fun taking a few staged shots, I usually go for 3 staged shots that way I have heaps of choice for my images needed for the project I am working on.

Find the Fstop function at the top of your phone the lowest you go the more blurred your background is.
